

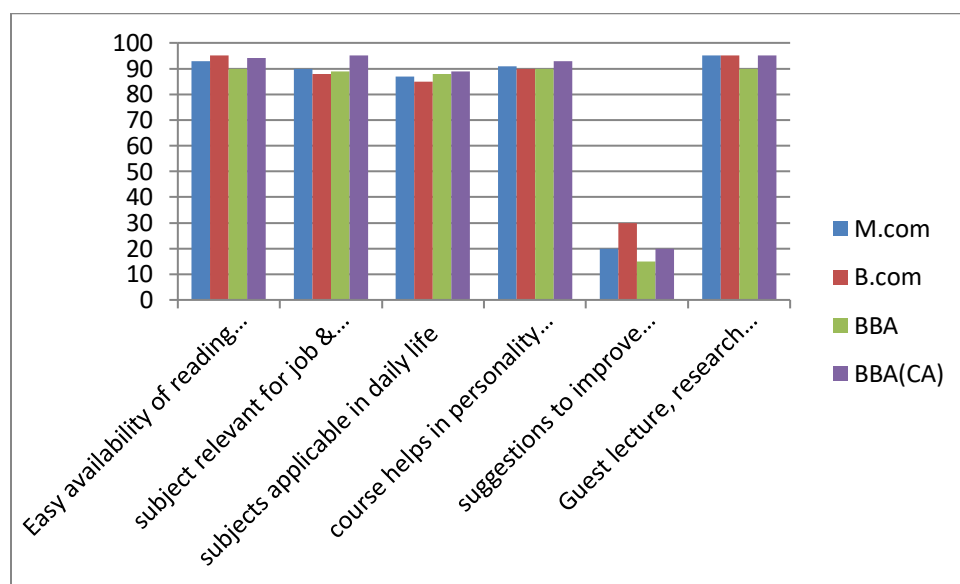

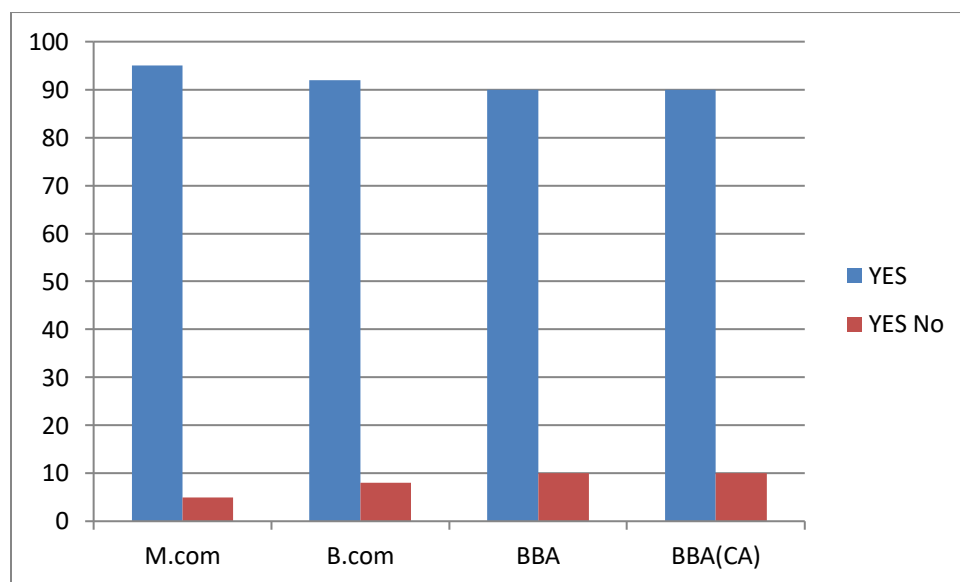

They found that the study material & references of course was easily available by the mentor and in the library. Students expressed their satisfaction in understanding most of the subjects and few subject proved helpful in developing their personality.

It has been analyzed from the students feedback that the college has easy availability of the study or reading material in the e-library and central library, the respondents agree upto 95% on the relevancy of the subjects to their job profiles and future aspirations, 92% of the responds agreed that the subjects are applicable in daily life and also helps in developing their personality, 94% of respondents agreed on guest lectures, research projects and workshops organized by the college are the best part of the curriculum.

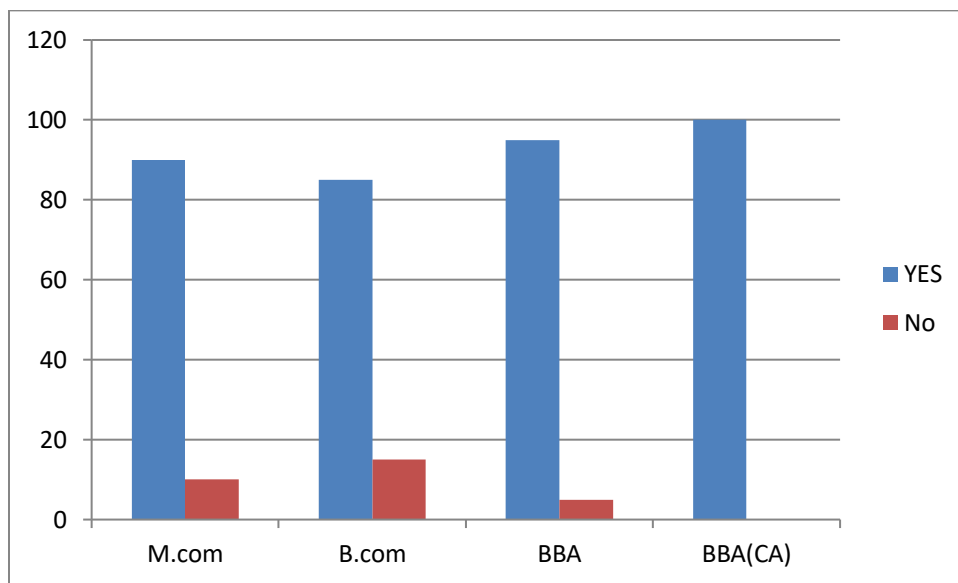

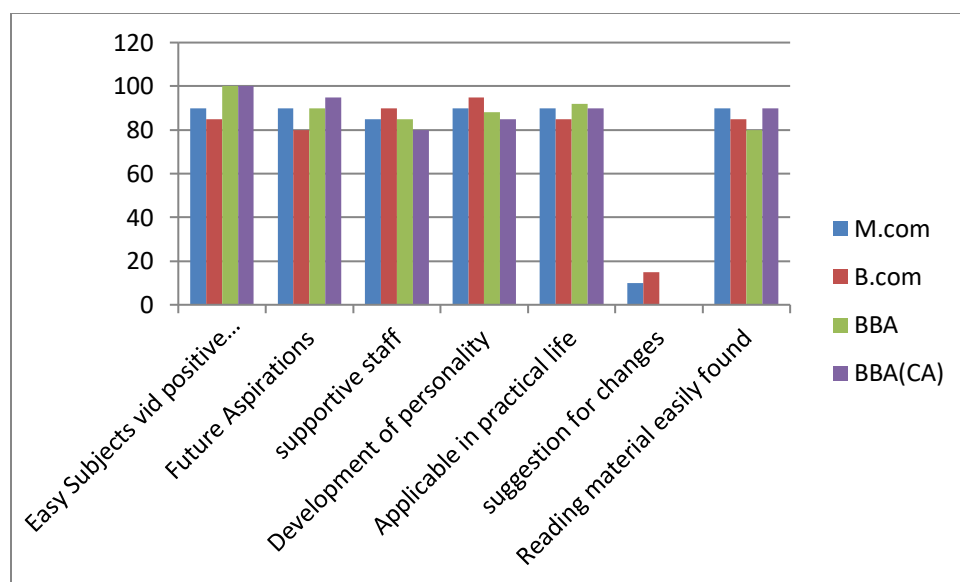
According to the employer's feedback it is observed that the curriculum of the course is satisfactory. Employers are satisfied by basic technical skills of the employees gained throughout the course in the college.
