## 1) Introduction:

The B.A Degree Course (2021 pattern) will be introduced in the following order:-

- |    |                         |                  |
|----|-------------------------|------------------|
| a. | <b>First Year B.A.</b>  | <b>2021-2022</b> |
| b. | <b>Second Year B.A.</b> | <b>2022-2023</b> |
| c. | <b>Third Year B.A.</b>  | <b>2023-2024</b> |

- ✓ B.A Degree Course will consist of **six semesters** divided into **three years**.
- ✓ The first year (Semester I and II), Second Year (Semester III and IV) and Third Year (Semester V and VI) Semester-End Examination will be held at the end of each semester.

## 2) Eligibility:

- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board with English as a passing subject.
- Admission to the Third Semester (Second Year) will be based on the satisfactory clearance(earning 60% of the total credits i.e. 26 credits) of the first two Semesters.
- Admission to the Fifth Semester (Third Year) will be based on complete clearance(100%) of first two semesters (all 44 credits of FYBA are earned) and satisfactory clearance of the third and fourth semesters (i.e. 60% of credits i.e 26 credits are earned).

## 3) A.T.K.T. Rules:

- Minimum **60%** core courses(26 credits) have to be qualified in the I<sup>st</sup> and II<sup>nd</sup> semester, then only will the student be allowed in the III<sup>rd</sup> semester (2<sup>nd</sup> year B.A).
- Minimum **44** credits have to be earned by the students in the **1<sup>st</sup>** year. Then the students will be allowed in the **3<sup>rd</sup>** year which means **students have to clear all the compulsory courses of 1<sup>st</sup> year.**

#### 4) Courses Carrying Practicals:

- a) In B.A. course, the subject of Psychology will have practical course of **three** credits.
- b) There will be practical and practical examinations for the Special Course in Psychology (Discipline Special Elective) of T.Y.B.A (Semester V & VI)

#### 6) Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction for B.A Degree course shall be English except for languages.

#### 7) Duration:

The course shall be a full-time course and the duration of the course shall be for three years.If the student fails to complete the course in three years ,two more years will be given to complete the course. The student can complete the course in maximum of **five** years.

#### 8) Attendance:

No candidate shall be admitted to the semester end examinations unless he/ she has satisfactorily completed 75% of attendance for both the semesters.

#### 9) College Terms:

The dates for the commencement and conclusion of the first and the second terms shall be as determined by the College Authorities. Only duly admitted students can keep the terms. The present relevant college ordinances pertaining to grant of terms will be applicable.

#### **10) Verification and Revaluation:**

The candidate may apply for verification and revaluation of result through Principal of College which will be done by the **college** as per ordinance framed in this behalf.

#### **11) Standard of Passing:**

- A student must obtain a minimum of 40% marks in Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE), and minimum 40% marks in Semester End Examination in each subject.
- It means that passing separately in Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination in each subject is compulsory .
- Students who have failed in Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) of any semester can reappear for the same in the very next semester. E.g. students failed in 1<sup>st</sup> semester can reappear in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and students failed in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester can appear in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester etc.

#### **12) Methods of Evaluation, Passing, and Evaluation Criteria:**

The evaluation of students will be done on **three** parameters:-

a)Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE)

b)Practical Examination (Only in the subject of Psychology) (**SEM-V &SEM- VI**)

(Details of course having practical ie Psychology is given in Sr. No. 5)

c)Semester- End Examination

- **For Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE)**, Evaluation will be done continuously. Internal assessment will be of **40** marks. These 40 marks are divided as follows:

❖ Minor variations may be adjusted by the institution.

- 1) A student obtaining Grade F shall be considered failed and will be required to reappear in the examination.
- 2) For non-credit courses ‘Satisfactory’ or ‘unsatisfactory’ shall be indicated instead of the letter grade and this will not be counted for the computation of SGPA/CGPA.
- 3) The universities can decide on the or percentage of marks required to pass in a course and also the CGPA required to qualify for a degree taking into consideration the recommendations of the statutory professional councils such as AICTE, MCI, BCI, NCTE etc.
- 4) The statutory requirement for eligibility to enter as an assistant professor in colleges and universities in the disciplines of arts, science, commerce etc. is a minimum average mark of 50% and 55% in relevant postgraduate degree respectively for reserved and general category.

#### 14. Improvement Of Class:

- 1) A Candidate will be allowed to re-appear for the examination for improvement of Class or grade within a period of 2 years from the date of his/her passing



bachelors degree examination. Only 1 attempt for improvement will be allowed, according to the syllabus in existence at the time of improvement.

- 2) A Candidate shall have to reappear for minimum 1/3 rd and /or maximum all the theory courses at a time on which the class is awarded.
- 3) A Candidate who has appeared for improvement of class and fails to improve his/her class , his/her performance at such reappearance shall be ignored.
- 4) A Candidate appearing for the improvement of Class grade, shall not be entitled to be in the list of Rankholders/ Merit holders.
- 5) Improved Candidate will have to surrender the degree, Statement of marks, passing certificate in original, after the declaration of their results of the concerned improved class. After surrendering the above documents in original new certificate will be issued in due course of time as in usual process.
